If you are interested, just give us a call in the shop.

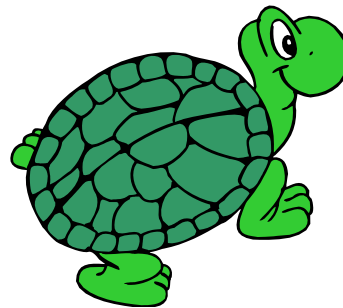
