Hole- in- One:

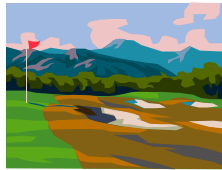
Congratulations to John Kang who was able to put that small ball in the 17th hole from the tee in one shot on February 17th
